

Aimed at:

- Music students and amateurs of all levels

- Pianists who wish to have a closer experience with a playing such a special instrument.

String players who want to experience playing the classical repertoire with a fortepiano and get to know expressive tools and stylistic features of the period.

- Chamber music groups

Contents:

- Introduction by Artem Belogurov about the Stein copy, its constructive elements, musical possibilities and suitable repertoire.
 - Active Participants should prepare excerpts or movements of a piece in their classical repertoire (for example, Haydn, Mozart, early Beethoven, CPE Bach, etc.)
- We will work on the pieces proposed by the participants and use examples from the string trios by Haydn, Mozart and Beethoven to showcase the different musical concepts

Chamber music:

- Pre-formed groups will have the opportunity to work on their piece (consult discounts for groups)
- Musicians that would like to try out pieces that involve the violin and/or cello and the use of the fortepiano will be paired with other musicians and/or the tutors.

Remarks:

- String players are welcome to use gut strings and period classical bow, but modern set-up is also accepted The pitch will be 430 Hz
- Reduced cost for active participation in the workshop for individual students is 18€, consult further discounts for groups
